#### Spelling:

To use their phonic knowledge confidently to make accurate, plausible phonetic attempts at spelling.

#### Grammar:

Capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Day:	Learning Objective:	Lesson:
Monday	<b>Phonics:</b> to be able to confidently recall the phase 3 sounds.	<p><b>9.20am</b> - Live Phonics on Zoom – Phonics Scavenger Hunt</p> <p><b>Task:</b> Look at the items you have gathered from around the house. Can you segment the words into the sounds? E.g. coat = c-oa-t.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Have a go at writing the words down using the sounds you can hear e.g. scissors = s-i-z-r-s.</p>
Tuesday	<b>English:</b> to retrieve information from books accurately and to begin writing short sentences in meaningful contexts.	<p><b>9.20am</b> – Live English (Reading and Writing) on Zoom – Mad About Dinosaurs</p> <p><b>Task:</b> Think carefully about the descriptions in the book. What type of dinosaur do you think has hatched out of our egg? Look at the adjectives and then look at our dinosaur. Is it scaly? Is it big or small? Does it have a long or short neck? Write down what you think we should do with the dinosaur. Draw a picture of your idea to go with it. Try to write at least 2 sentences. Wednesday	<b>Phonics:</b> to begin spelling Phase 3 tricky words accurately	<p><b>9.20am</b> – Live Phonics on Zoom – Guess My Word</p> <p><b>Task:</b> Have a go at playing ‘Guess My Word’ with somebody at home. Take it in turns to segment and blend e.g. one person gives the clues and segments the word whilst the other one guesses the word and writes it down. After a few turns swap places.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Can you write the word in a sentence?</p>
Thursday	<b>WORLD BOOK DAY</b>	<p><b>9.20am</b> – Live World Book Day – <b>Please bring along your favourite book to share with the rest of the class.</b></p> <p><b>Task:</b> Today is World Book Day. Have a go at one of the World Book Day activities.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Can you explain to somebody at home what World Book Day is?</p>
Friday	<b>Phonics:</b> to use their increasing phonic knowledge to blend and read words quickly and accurately.	<p><b>9.20am</b> – Live Phonics on Zoom – Phonics Bingo</p> <p><b>Task:</b> Log onto Phonics Play (username: jan21 password: home) Go to Resources → Phase 3 → Make a Match Game Have a go at playing the game. Click on the cards to turn them over and see if you can make a matching pair.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> When you click on a picture card, see if you can write down the word before you click on another card.</p>
