

# What is an Adverb?

An adverb is something that tells you where, why or how something is done. For example:



Camilla crossed the road **safely**.



Saffie's horse **bravely** jumped over the hurdle.

The Moroccan man rode his camel **everywhere**.



Many adverbs end in -ly but **not all of them**. Similarly, not all words which end in -ly are adverbs.
