<p>Spelling: To learn to spell words with the /k/ sound spelt 'ch'.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Look at the images with the words written underneath.• Look at the words carefully and then have a go at writing them down. Highlight the parts of the words that are tricky to remember.• This week practise spelling these words. Use the spelling strategies sheets to help you.• Ask someone to text you on them at the end of the week. Post me your score on Seesaw when you have done your test.• Play Egg Hunt on https://www.spellzone.com/word_lists/games-109.htm with 'ch' for the /k/ sound words.	
<p>Grammar:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read the 'What is an adverb?' help sheet to remind yourself what they are.• Look at the 'Adventurous Adverbs' sheets and come up with adverbs to describe the picture.• Choose a photo that you have at home or take a photo of yourself doing something exciting. How many adverbs can you use to describe your picture? Can you upload the picture and the adverbs to your Seesaw account?

Remember to use your senses as we practised in class. There is a sheet to help you labelled 'Activity 1 English resources'.• Record your ideas in your home learning book as a thought shower (there is a model in the resources).• You can also read Chapter 1 of the book, which I have included on our class page to help you gather ideas if you would like.	
<p>Activity 2</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Writing Task• Your task is to write a letter from Mole to a friend to invite them to come and experience the river. You need to include:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ A description of the river setting using your senses.○ An explanation why you think they should come and visit the river with you.○ An idea of what you will do with your friend at the river.• Please write your letter in your home learning book and upload me a picture of it to your Seesaw account. I look forward to reading them!
