You can choose to write from the list of ideas below. <ul style="list-style-type: none">-Write a newspaper report; Boy goes to the moon.- Write a narrative of this story, experiment with narrative voice, 1st person, 3rd person etc.- Describe the different creatures he sees,-Write a dialogue between the boy and some of the characters.- Choose a planet and describe the strange creatures you find there. <ul style="list-style-type: none">Remember your writing targets. Can you include varied sentence openers? Impress me with your different types of effective and accurate punctuation.Read out your writing to someone. Does it sound effective? Can you improve it?Have fun with words and impress your audience.
