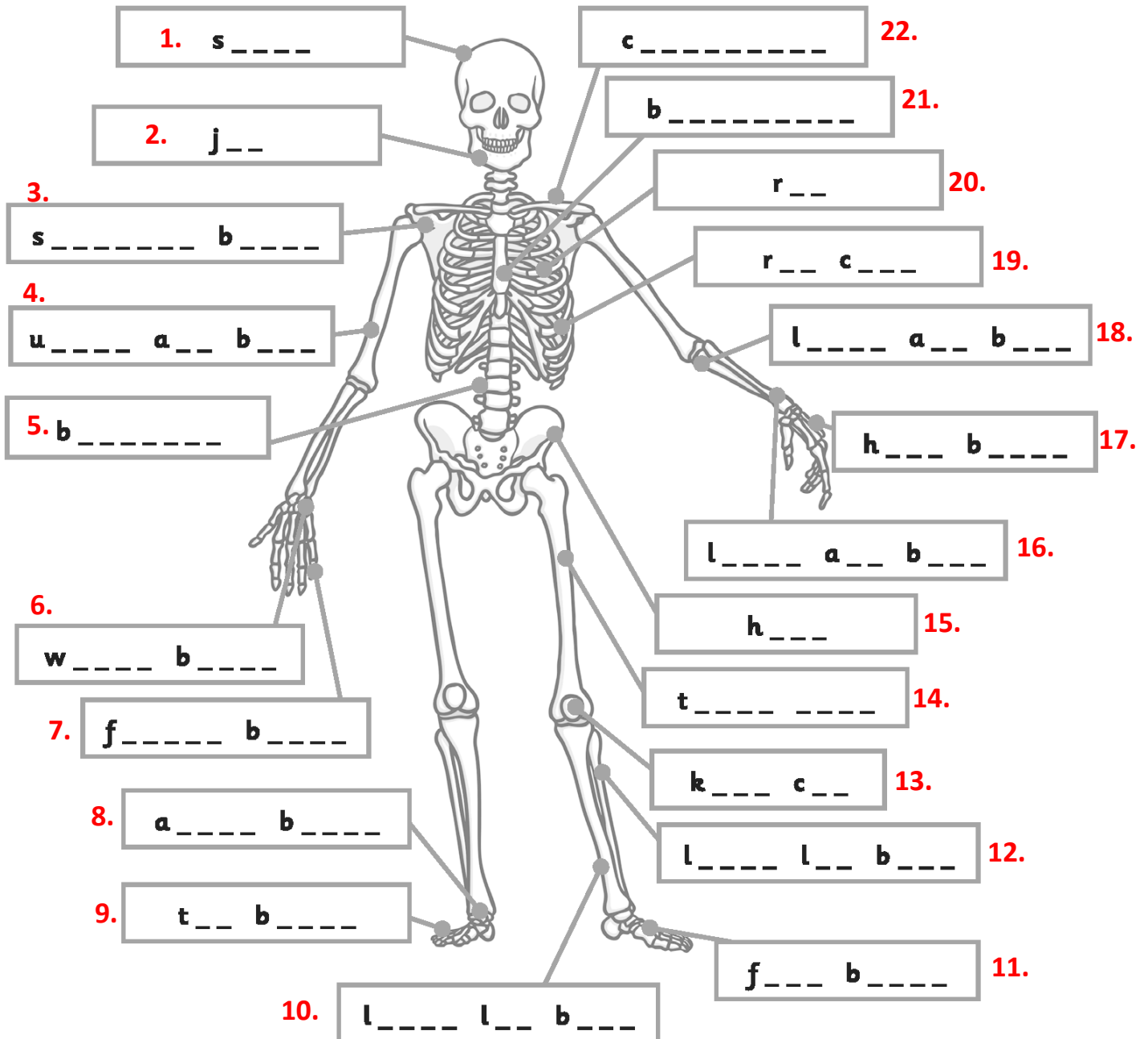


Naming Bones

Using the initial letter clues and the word bank at the bottom of the page, can you correctly label the bones of the body with their common names?

NOTE: If you do not want to print out the skeleton, instead write a numbered list of the correct bone names.



Word Bank: skull, rib, rib cage, collarbone, ankle bones, upper arm bone, thigh bone, lower leg bone, finger bones, hand bones, shoulder blade, jaw, backbone, wrist bones, hips, knee cap, foot bones, lower arm bones, toe bones, breastbone.

Naming Bones Game

Instructions

Equipment needed:

- Your completed 'Naming Bones' skeleton (page above)
- A copy of the 'Mini Skeleton' bones, one per play (page below)

How to play:

1. Take turns to point to a bone in your body e.g. ribs.
2. The other player must name the bone you are pointing to.
(Answers can be checked using your completed 'Naming Bones' skeleton above).
3. If you give the correct bone name you can choose a bone cut out and begin to build your own mini skeleton.
4. If you give an incorrect answer you cannot collect a bone.
5. The first player to have a completed mini skeleton is the winner!

Play onscreen / without printing out

- Follow the same rules as above, but instead using the cut out mini skeleton bones to build a skeleton, simply use it as a guide and draw your own skeleton a bone at a time. The first player to draw a completed mini skeleton is the winner!
