This week is the number bonds week! We are looking at number bonds to 10 and becoming super confident with them. If your child has an older sibling then they will also know the number bond song. We have been singing it in class since October with the children. I've added some links to different ones on YouTube that the children might like to listen to. Children need to be very confident with their number bonds to 10 before they start on their number bonds to 20. When the children are very secure with ordering numbers to twenty, recognition to twenty and 1-10 number bonds then they can start on number bonds to 20. Any of the activities can be extended to 20

This Week's Maths Tasks	WC 11 th May
Mental Maths: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Days of the week, weather chart and days of the week song.• Number 'puddle jump' game.• Throw a ball and say a number, the catcher has to say the corresponding number bond ie thrower says 8, the catcher says 2• Practice number formation 1-20• Dinosaur feet and claws• Count your teddies give them each a number and then tell an adult which number you have given them, can you order them.	
Activity 1 – Singing the number bonds song <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The children have been singing a number bonds song since the Autumn term. See below• Ask your child to sing it to you.• If you have Lego make towers using two colours of bricks to represent the number bonds	
Activity 2 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can you record your child singing the number bond song either outside or inside with some good actions. They can 'rap' it if they want! Or make up their own. The children have really impressed us with how confident they all are at starring in videos• The children could act out their number bonds with teddies, or toys.• They could use the sticks or stones that they collected a few weeks ago to make number bond number sums.	

Activity 3 Number bond Hands



- Help your child to trace around their hands and then cut them out. Stick the palms onto a piece of paper and use the fingers to help work out their number bonds. Write the number bonds below. If they are struggling writing the sums out just get your child to write one of the numbers from each equation.

Activity 4 Number bond rainbow



- Make a number bonds rainbow. Ask your child to make their sums nice and colourful.
