For possession of singular nouns:



The boy's umbrella

(The umbrella belonging to the boy)




The cat's toys

(The toys belonging to the cat)


Add 's to the noun

Apostrophes

For possession of singular nouns ending in s:



Jess's hat



Ross's car

Add 's to the noun, even if it ends in s

Apostrophes

For possession of plural nouns:



The sheep's field



The men's football match

Add 's to the word

Apostrophes

For possession of plural nouns ending in s



The girls' drinks



The puppies' bed

Add only ' to the plural noun if it ends in s
