<b>Activity 1-You must complete these activities in order!</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Now you all have a copy of the book Skellig- Read the book to pg19 where the new character of Mina is introduced. What does the author reveal about her character only from the 2 pages?</li> <li>Write the next chapter after Mina has been introduced. You must maintain the style of the author. Think about your personal writing targets and make it the best writing you can do! This is an extended piece so try to spend at least 30-45 minutes on it.</li> </ul>	
<b>Activity 2</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Read to up to chapter 11- reread chapter 10 again- think about the meaning behind Michael's very strange dream-what do you think it means? Have you ever had a strange dream-what do you think the dream was trying to tell you?</li> </ul>	
<b>Activity 3</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Read up to chapter 12 and complete the 'Book Talk' review sheet of the story so far!</li> </ul>	
<b>Activity 4</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Read the beginning of chapter 13 and stop at the top of page 40-what exactly do you think <i>they</i> are? Carry on reading to the end of the chapter. What do you think of when you think of an angel? Draw an image of an angel and add descriptive words around the image.</li> </ul>
