Example Inform - to <u>give</u> facts. Information - facts that have <u>been</u> <u>provided or learned</u>.</li> <li>Use your suffix words in <b>your spelling tasks</b>: Pyramid spellings, copy trace, look cover write, missing vowels.</li> </ul>	
<p><b><u>Activity 1</u></b> - Read up to the end of Chapter 5, if you haven't already!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Research the title Dulce Domum. Latin as a language spread across Europe with the rise of the Roman Empire.</li> <li>Using a simple English to Latin translator such as Google Translate, can you list some other words from chapter 5 Wind in the Willows.</li> <li>Can you find any words that are a close match to the translated word? For example; school = scholae and pirate = pirata.</li> </ul>	
<p><b><u>Activity 2</u></b> - Re-read page 50.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Look at the text on page 64 where it says <i>'PLEASE stop, Ratty!' pleaded the poor Mole, in anguish of heart. 'You don't understand! It's my home, my old home!'</i> Why is Mole feeling like this and Ratty is keen to press on and Mole desperately wants to stop. Can you explain why?</li> </ul>	
<p><b><u>Activity 3</u></b> - Grammar Task - Plural and Possessive Apostrophe.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Copy and complete the practice sheet POSSESSIVE APOSTROPHE AND PLURAL_S</li> <li>Using Chapter 5 Search through for how possessive apostrophe is being used, then list 5 of them.</li> <li>Again, using Chapter 5, search for how plurals are used, then list 5 of them.</li> </ul>
