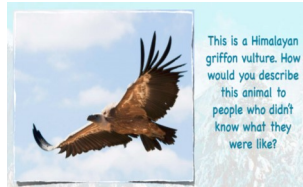


Science

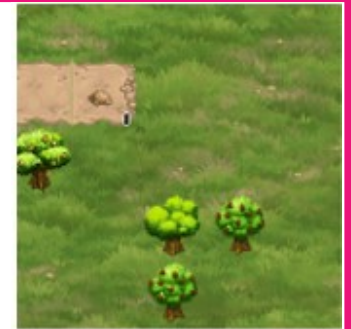
