

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#### **Mental Maths**

• 5 minutes each day on Times Tables Rockstars. Remember to complete a Studio activity once each week.

#### **Activity 1** – Measuring length in centimetres

- Watch the video lesson on the White Rose Maths website about measuring in cm (Choose Summer term Wk 1 Lesson 3 click here)
- Measure the lengths in cm of different objects around your home.
- Complete the attached Maths worksheet for Activity 1.



#### Top tips:

- Make sure that you've got the ruler the right way round (the numbers aren't upside down!) and that you are using the cm scale.
- When you start measuring, always line up the zero line on the ruler with the edge of the object that you're measuring (don't line the object up with the end of the ruler!)

## Activity 2 - Measuring length in metres

- Watch the video lesson on the White Rose Maths website about measuring in cm (Choose Summer term Wk 1 Lesson 4 click <u>here</u>)
- Make yourself a metre stick or strip. Use a 30cm ruler to measure out 100 cm on a garden cane, long strip of paper or piece of string (30cm + 30cm + 30cm + 10cm).
- Use your 1m measuring stick to measure the lengths in m of different things around your home. You might have to go into the garden and measure the length of the car, garden path, gate or your front door.
- Complete the attached Maths worksheet for Activity 2.


### Activity 3 – Comparing lengths

Remember that:


- < means less than (smaller than)

- > means greater than (bigger than)




