Research the term 'rite of passage'. Make a list of key rites of passage.

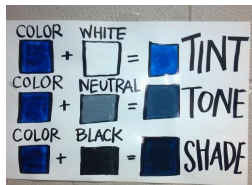
This week we will think about the life journey of Jesus. I want you to research the key events of his life and then make a comparison grid of someone with no faith.

Choose one of his mountain pictures first and then follow the steps on the help sheet.

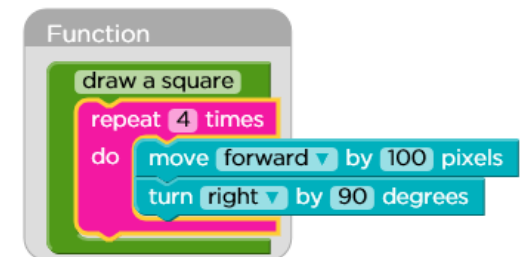
