Tenses are used to show <u>when</u> something is happening. Look at theses examples below:

Verb = watch

I <u>watched</u> the television.	PAST
I was watching the television.	PAST
I <u>watch</u> the television.	PRESENT
I am watching the television.	PRESENT
I <u>will watch</u> the television.	FUTURE
I am going to watch the television.	FUTURE
