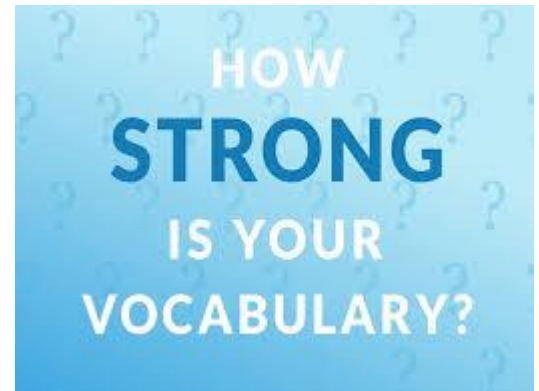


NEW VOCABULARY

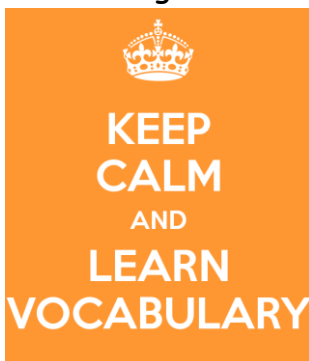
From this week, before you read each chapter, you will be asked to learn some NEW VOCABULARY.

This is important because:

- It will help you to read the chapter more easily.
- You will gradually build your English vocabulary, helping to make future reading easier.



You may learn the vocabulary in the way you find best for your own style of learning. Here are some suggestions:



- Look up and write the definition in English.
- Ask a member of your family.
- Draw a picture of the word.
- Make a word web.
- Use the word in a sentence.

Whichever way you choose, each word must be written carefully in your Home Learning work book. You could put it at the back titled "New Vocabulary".

To help you, try some of the following games and strategies:

- Play "Spot the vocabulary word" as you read.
- Try using some of the new vocabulary words when you talk to others in your house, or in your next piece of writing.
- Test yourself from time to time.
