Statements:

Statements are sentences which tell you something. They end in a full stop.

Questions:

Questions are sentences which ask you something. They usually end with a question mark.

Commands:

Commands are sentences which tell you to do something. They can be short and urgent or angry. They can end in a full stop or exclamation mark.

Exclamations:

Exclamations are sentences which state something with strong feeling or emotion. They often begin with 'How' or 'What' and end in an exclamation mark.
