

Pronouns

A **pronoun** is a word that takes the place of a **noun**.

Instead of saying- **Michael** went to the yacht and **Michael** picked up the rope.

We would say; **Michael** went to the yacht and **he** picked up the rope.

We have used the pronoun **he** instead of the noun **Michael**.
