

Mountain climates are colder because of their high altitude. The higher up a mountain you go, the colder it gets, as Steve Backshall shows here.



Many mountain ranges are so high, their peaks are covered in snow all year round.



Even mountains near the equator, like Kilimanjaro in Africa, have snow at their summits, even in the summer months.

The climate in mountain ranges changes throughout the year. This is the famous Alpine town of Zermatt in Switzerland.

After days of climbing, you might be lucky enough to see this view. If you did, you would be just a few hundred metres from the summit.




If you reach the top, it's worth it just for the <u>view</u>. Of course you have to take a photo to show your grandchildren.






