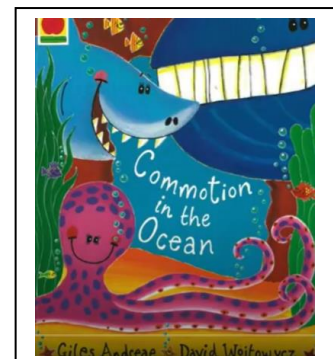
- **Letters and Sounds**
- Use the Phonics Play website - Username: march20 and Password: home
- Parents will need to choose phase 2 or 3, if you refer to the sheet I gave for the first week the first sounds are s, a, t these are phase 2. Phase 3 sounds start with j. Please stick to the phase that your child is working on. If you are unsure please message me on Tapestry and I'll let you know which phase you need.
- This week let's focus on these sounds
- We will be learning new sounds from now on so please use Mr Thorne does phonics on YouTube if you are unsure.
- Phase 2 - zz, qu play Buried Treasure using Phase 3 set 1-6 zz and qu.
- Phase 3 - in school we will be practising reading and spelling two-syllable words like bedroom, toothbrush and armchair. Mrs Waller will add a video to Tapestry linked to this.
- You can also play pick a Picture and choose the Phase 3 digraphs, this is great for practising blending.
- Keep an eye on Tapestry for a video linked to your sounds.
- Can you write down some words using these sounds?
- Even better, can you write some words using the sounds and then put them in a sentence?
- Can you find these sounds in words on packaging or in books or newspapers?

Activity 1

- Write a list of things that you would see at the seaside. For example sand, waves, bucket and spade.
- Draw pictures to go with your list. (Yellow highlighting means we will complete this activity in school).

- What do they look like? Describe them to a sibling or grandparent.

- The Starfish
- Which is the best and why?
