



# The Plant Guide



You have been asked to use your scientific findings to create a TV programme to show people how to look after their plants. You must make sure you tell your audience what plants need to grow well. Use this plan to help you structure your ideas. The words in *italics* give you examples for each section.

## 1. Greet your audience and introduce yourself:

*Welcome to 'The Good Plant Growing Guide!' I'm ...*  
*We are going to explain everything you need to know to look after your plants.*

## 2. Explain the investigation – what did we do with the 4 plants:

*We put one plant in the cold room so that it had no warmth. We noticed that...*

3. Tell your audience what you found out about the things that plants need to grow well and what they should do with their plants:
