Use your suffix and prefix words that you found or those from above in **your spelling tasks**: Pyramid spellings, copy trace, look cover write, missing vowels.

Activity 1 - Before you read each chapter, you will need to complete some of the tasks in **NEW VOCABULARY** for the new words below.

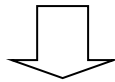
The words from Chapter 4 are:
