

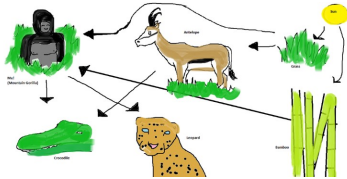

Food Webs. Last week we looked at Mountain Food Chains this week you will be creating a mountain food web. Check the sheet 'Food Webs' Activity sheet .

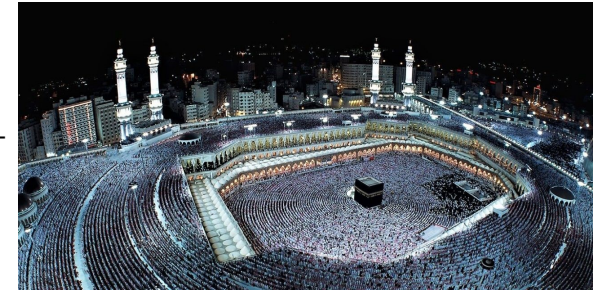
The diagram illustrates a mountain food web with the following components and energy flow:

- Producers:** Grass (labeled 'Grass'), Bamboo (labeled 'Bamboo'), and a Yellow flower (labeled 'Flower').
- Primary Consumers:** A Goat (labeled 'Goat') eats Grass. A Rabbit (labeled 'Rabbit') eats Bamboo. A Snake (labeled 'Snake') eats the Yellow flower.
- Secondary Consumers:** A Leopard (labeled 'Leopard') eats the Goat, the Rabbit, and the Snake.
- Tertiary Consumer:** A Human (labeled 'Human') eats the Goat.

Arrows indicate the direction of energy flow from the producers to the various levels of consumers.
