- **thought** – four cases (*bought, thought, nought, sought*).

Make a list of any words you find, checking your spellings carefully.

**Activity 1** - Before you read each chapter, you will need to complete some of the tasks in **NEW VOCABULARY** for the new words below.



The words from Chapter 5 are:
