

# FRIENDS!

TASK: Imagine you are all alone in the playground and needed someone to play with! You decide to do something about it and want to place an advertisement for a friend.

1. Do some research of job adverts on the internet to get an idea of what it should look like.
2. Create a job application for the role of being your friend and being friend to them too!
3. What would the key features of the job involve, for both you and the applicant? You could use your list of words from task one to help here!
4. Make a list of all those who might apply (not names) e.g. brother / sister / neighbour / school / park / club?
5. Make sure you explain in your advert that your friendship will most likely have ups and downs and there will be times where one of you may not be loyal friend. There may be good reason for this as loyalty is a big problem for even the best of friendships, as deciding when to be loyal and when not to be loyal is tricky! Have a look at the scenarios below...
