When you read a report especially on digital platforms such as SeeSaw and others like Twitter, Instagram, Facebook etc, there are certain features that are used to make it better for the reader.

Task 1: Have a look back at your work now, and then give a response to each of the three key points below:

- Did you or anyone else **Proof Read** your work to make sure it was good? Proof reading is a really tricky job, especially if you wrote the piece, as you may not spot your own mistakes.
- What **Font** did you use? The type of Font you use can have a big impact on the reader if they find it difficult to read they may not buy or look again at your work!
- What **Extra Features** did you use? Such as photos and especially the use of links to other sites / areas of interest or for more information about a sportsperson or venue or even adverts and videos linked to that sport.
