Grammar: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Open 'Grammar – Paragraphs & Sub Headings – Lesson Guidance'. Read through the information on how to use paragraphs and sub-headings. Verbally discuss and complete the onscreen activities before looking at the answers. (This resource does not need to be printed and written out. It can just be done through discussion).• Open 'Grammar – Sort the Paragraphs - Activity 1'. In non-fiction texts, paragraphs are often grouped below a sub-heading. Can you sort the plant facts into the table, below the appropriate sub-heading?• Open 'Grammar – Sub Headings - Activity 2'. Read the text and think carefully about what each paragraph is about. Then write an appropriate sub-heading for each paragraph.	
Activity 1 – Visualisation <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read Chapter 7 (page 207-235) and think about the following questions:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ What is Will describing on page 208?○ Why does Will decide it would be safer to live as an orang-utan? (page 211)○ What did Will name the orang-utans? Describe how Will came up with a name for each one. (pages 215 to 216)○ What happened that persuaded Will to move on from the nest they had created? (page 219)○ What do you think happened to Will's mum? (page 221)○ Why were the orang-utans imitating Will? (page 222)○ Name some of the emotions orang-utans can feel which are the same as human emotions. (page 223)○ Why does the author put part of a word in italics in "unhuman"? (page 224)○ Discuss the uses of the hyphen and the dash on page 224.

- How would you have felt if you were Will at the end of Chapter 7? (page 235)
- Choose a page from the chapter and create a visualisation (picture) of the scene you imagine.
- Write a quote from the page underneath that describes what you have drawn. Don't forget to include the page number.

Activity 2 – Chapter 7 Comprehension Questions

- Think about the chapter that you read in the previous activity.
- Have a go at the comprehension questions on English Activity 2. There are three levels – Try it, Challenge and Master. Everyone should have a go at the first two levels and if you fancy a challenge give the third level a try!

Activity 3

- Read pages 237-249 and think about the questions below:
 - Why do you think Chapter 8 is called 'Burning Bright'? (page 237)
 - What adjectives are used to describe Oona? (page 242)
 - Discuss the use of the word "chilling" to describe Mister Anthony's words Will is remembering. (page 244)
 - Discuss the phrase "intrepid determination". (page 249)
- Where do you think Oona is leading them to? Have a go at drawing a picture of where you think Oona is taking them to and have a go at writing a paragraph about it.

Activity 4 -

- Read pages 249-268 (The end of Chapter 8) and consider the following questions:
 - What does a "mass exodus" mean? (page 251)
 - Why do you think Will is unsure if he ever wants to go home? (page 253)
 - Describe the bear that they come across on page 254.
 - Why does Will describe where they are as a "strange new landscape"? What other words does he go on to use to describe it? (page 257)
 - Where do you think Other One is leading them to? (page 261)
- Predictor – Write a paragraph detailing how you think the story will end. With 2 chapters remaining in the book how do you think it will end. Have a go at writing your own detailed prediction for the end of the book.
 - What do you think is going to happen next? Will they ever get out of the jungle?
 - Do you think Will will have to live in the jungle with his new "family" forever?
