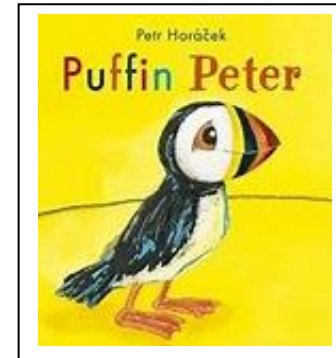
This Week's English Tasks

- **Letters and Sounds**
- Use the Phonics Play website - Username: march20 and Password: home
- Parents will need to choose phase 2 or 3, if you refer to the sheet I gave for the first week the first sounds are s, a, t these are phase 2. Phase 3 sounds start with j. Please stick to the phase that your child is working on. If you are unsure please message me on Tapestry and I'll let you know which phase you need.
- This week let's focus on these sounds
- This week we are now all learning or revising the sounds **ai** and **ee**.
- Watch the video on Tapestry.
- You can choose any of the games on Phonics play using these digraphs.
- Can you write down some words using these sounds?
- Even better, can you write some words using the sounds and then put them in a sentence?
- Can you play hopscotch using these words?

Activity 1

- How do you think Peter felt when he became lost?
- Which birds did he find on his way?
- What did the whale realise at the end of the story?
- Draw your own picture of a puffin and name him/ her.



Activity 2

- Letter formation practise
- Use the laminated sheets to practise letter formation, if possible do this every day.
- Then watch the Tapestry videos to show you a little more information and have a go at the activities. (Completed in school)

Activity 3

- **Writing challenge** – during the summer holidays write and send a postcard or letter to a friend! Ask them to write back so that you can be pen pals, they don't have to live far away – they could even live in Kendal!

- **A-Z challenge.** Write down the letters of the alphabet and then find something in your house beginning with each letter. A – apple, B – bed, C – cup...
