





This Week's Maths Tasks	WC 13 th July
<p>Mental Maths: Over the Summer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Number formation to 20• Counting in 1s, 2s, 5s, 10s• Rhymes and Songs: Days of the weeks, odd and even, doubles• Regular addition and subtraction within 20 (just a few each time).	
<p>Activity 1 - <u>Guess My Number</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Play I'm thinking of a number between 1 and 20.• Choose a number and write it down (remember to keep it hidden!).• The other players need to ask you questions to guess your number i.e. Is it less than ten? Is it odd or even? Does it end in a 5?• The winner is the first person to guess your number correctly.	
<p>Activity 2 Fish Bingo</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fish Bingo to 20: Write the numbers one to twenty on individual pieces of paper. Fold them up and place them in a bowl.• Below are some bingo cards but you can make your own, if you don't want to print them.	
<p>Activity 3</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">•  Paint an egg box to look like a treasure chest.• Write the numbers 1 to 20 on pieces of paper (or your pebbles) and place them in the treasure chest.• Take two numbers out and add them together. Repeat this again until the treasure chest is empty.• You now own all the pirates treasure. Well done!!
