- Make up a rhythm or tune inspired by a habitat of your choice.

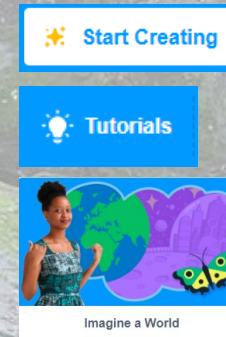
Build your own micro-habitat!
