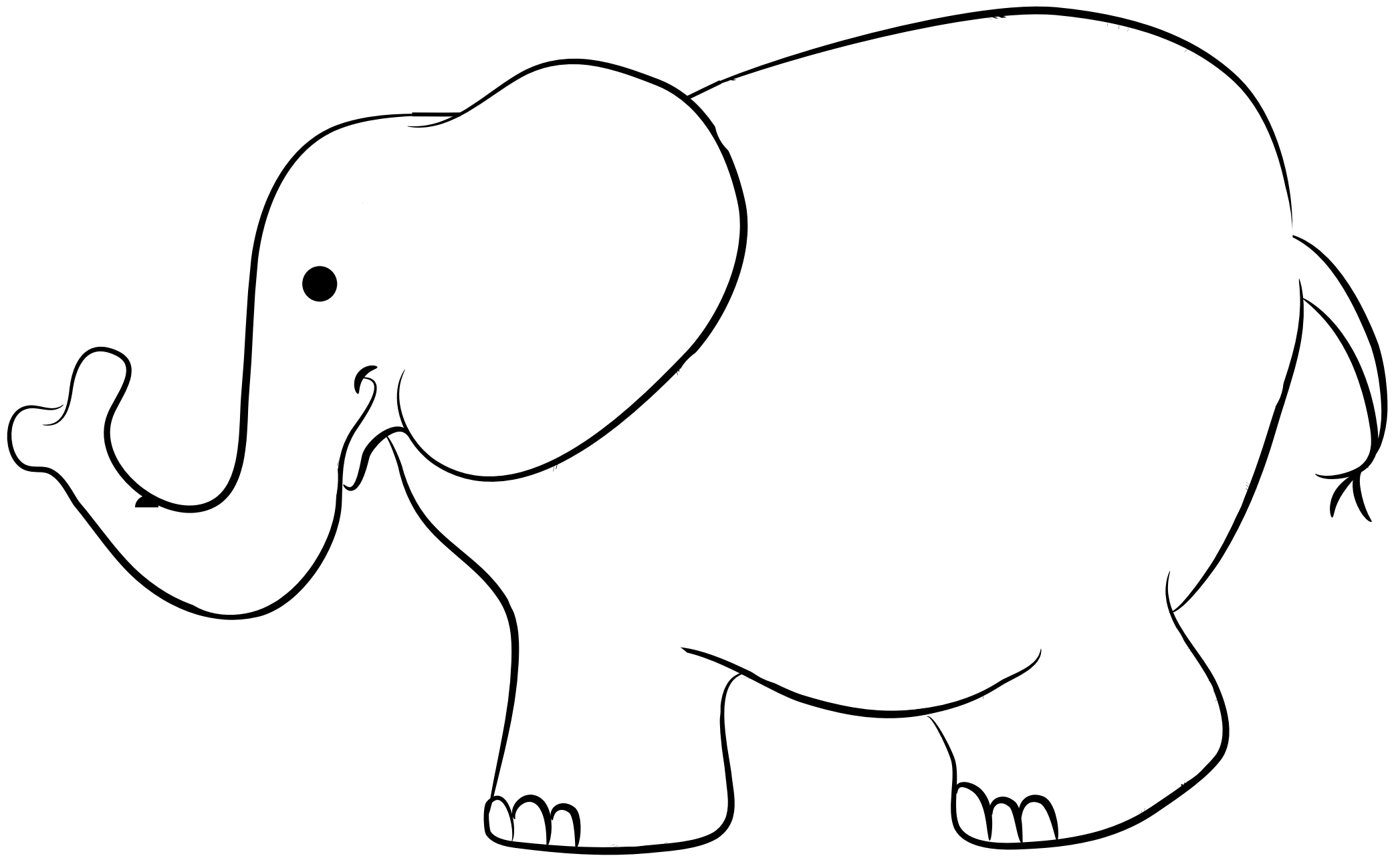

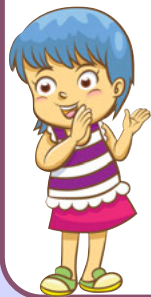
Elephant Template

Follow these steps to make a 3-D elephant for the elephant festival.

1. Cut out the two Elephant Templates and place them on top of each other.
2. Use a stapler to staple around the elephant but make sure you **leave the top open** so you can stuff your elephant later.
3. Decorate your elephant using felts, crayons, pastels, coloured pencils, glitter and sequins.
4. Don't forget to do the same on the other side.
5. Get some cotton wool and carefully push it into the elephant's legs and body. Once you have enough stuffing, staple the top of your elephant.

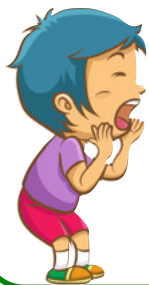
