Day:	Learning Objective:	Lesson:
Monday	Phonics: to learn the 'ow' sound and apply it in reading and writing words.	9.20am - Live Phonics on Zoom – 'ow' Task: Look at the 'ow' sheet. Can you work out which pictures have the 'ow' sound in them? (Not all of them do!) Once you have found them, have a go at writing the words and drawing the matching pictures. Challenge: see if you can work out what the other pictures are and write those down too.
Tuesday	Phonics: to learn the 'oi' sound and apply it in reading and writing words. English: to be able to retrieve information from books and to continue a rhyming string.	Pre Zoom Task: watch https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tk2Y9EAQ8eM (Phonics 'oi') 9.20am – Live English (Reading) on Zoom – Zog and the Flying Doctors Task: Complete the rhyming words activity. With a grown up read the sentences from the book and decide which word makes the sentence rhyme. 	in reading and writing words.	Task: Play the read and roll game. Roll the dice, read one of the words and write it down. Challenge: Can you make a sentence with a word from the mat?
Thursday	Phonics: to learn the 'air' sound and apply it in reading and writing words. English: to segment the sounds in simple words and to write captions	Pre Zoom Task: watch https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=E61NP6ioU5c (Phonics 'air') 9.20am – Live English (Writing) on Zoom – modelled writing Task: Can you write a list of things that doctors do? Aim for at least 3 things. Don't forget finger spaces! Challenge: can you draw a picture of a doctor above your list, and label the equipment they use?
Friday	Phonics: to consolidate the sounds taught this week and apply them in different contexts.	9.20am – Live Phonics on Zoom Task: Write the words below onto pieces of paper (you could hide them around the house to make this task more active!). Ask the children to read the words and sort them into ow, oi, ear, air words. Cow, owl, gown Coin, oink, foil Hear, near, gear Hair, chair, fair
