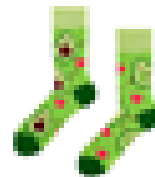
We would like you to join in with the R.S.P.B. birdwatch survey. It takes place during the last weekend in January. The link is in the useful websites box.

It's all about the number 2!

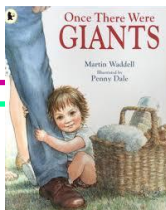
