Adjective to Adverb Game





Instructions

Equipment needed:

- Game board
- Dice
- Something to use as counters (for each player)

How to play:

- 1. Take turns to roll the dice and move around the board.
- 2. Read out the adjective you land on and then change it to an adverb by adding the suffix 'ly'.
- 3. If you spell the adverb correctly you can stay on that square.
- 4. If you spell the adverb incorrectly you must go back to the previous square you came from.
- 5. First player to the finish is the winner!
- 6. The answers are on page 3!

Play onscreen / without printing out

• Follow the same rules as above, but instead of using counters, each player must keep track of what number square they are on.

Spelling rule = add 'ly'	
soft	softly
loud	loudly
slow	slowly
brave	bravely
sudden	suddenly
quick	quick <mark>ly</mark>
silent	silent <mark>ly</mark>
beautiful	beautifully

Spelling rule = change y to i and add 'ly'		
crazy	craz <mark>ily</mark>	
happy	happ <mark>ily</mark>	
angry	angrily	
steady	steadily	
lucky	luckily	
greedy	greedily	

Spelling rule = change 'le' to 'ly'		
simple	simp <mark>ly</mark>	
humble	humb <mark>ly</mark>	
gentle	gent <mark>ly</mark>	
horrible	horrib <mark>ly</mark>	

Spelling rule = add 'ally' rather than 'ly'		
basic	basically	
frantic	frantically	
dramatic	dramatically
