Monday	Understanding the World PE (Mr Harris)	<p>11.20am – Topic Live on Zoom - Police Introduction Topic task: Police are very good at looking for clues to solve crimes. Use the household treasure hunt sheet to practice being a detective. What can you find around your house?</p> <p>Session 3 Shuttle Run challenge</p> <p>At home if you have enough space outside measure 10 big steps and mark out the run. (roughly 8-10m in length) You can use anything to mark out the steps for example use pebbles or mark a line with chalk. When you have measured out your 10 big steps practice running from outside to the other. Challenge - Once you have had a few practice goes see how many times you can complete the shuttle run without stopping or without walking. You could try the challenge using a bike or scooter? Again make a note of how many you can do email us your results.</p>

Tell a grown up about all the things you have learnt. Topic task: Using Lego, blocks or playdough build your own police station. Have a look at some pictures of a real police station. Understand the importance of personal hygiene.</p>	<p>Clean and Tidy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask a grown up to read the story “Clean and Tidy” about Sam and Dan’s sleep over. • Talk about the story – <p>What might the two friends do during their sleepover? Why do you think you should wash your hands before you eat? Why should you wash your hands after you’ve used the toilet? Why should you brush your teeth before you go to bed? Why do you think you should have a shower (or bath)? How often should you have one? Why should you wash and comb / brush your hair? Why do you think you should brush your teeth after your breakfast?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn this Song - ‘Brush your teeth’ (to the tune ‘Jingle bells’) <p>Brush your teeth, brush your teeth Give them all a treat Brush up and down and all around To keep them clean and neat.
