Day:	Learning Objective:	Lesson:
Monday	To match 6, 7 and 8 in a range on contexts.	<p>Maths Task: watch the White Rose Session 1 video – https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/early-years/growing-6-7-8-week-2/</p> <p>Task: Have a go at the White Rose Maths Task. If you can't print off the cards, cut up some pieces of paper and make your own. But remember you can only have 6, 7 or 8 dots on each ladybird!</p> <p>Challenge: Can you recognise the amount of dots without needing to count them?</p>
Tuesday	To develop their understanding of pairs and explore what happens with odd numbers.	<p>11.20am Maths Live on Zoom – Making Pairs</p> <p>Maths Task: Whilst you are on your daily walk, have a go at collecting some objects. Can you put them into pairs or are some of them odd numbers? How many pairs of objects can you make?</p> <p>Challenge: Can you explain why an odd amount of objects can't make a pair?</p>
Wednesday	To begin combining 2 groups of objects and using the vocabulary involved in addition.	<p>11.20am Maths Live on Zoom – Combining 2 Groups of Objects</p> <p>Maths Task: Collect some toys from around your house (no more than 10) and split them into 2 piles. How many do you have all together? Close your eyes and ask a grown up to take some away. How many are on each side now? How many are there altogether? Have a few goes at this game, changing the total number of toys each time.</p> <p>Challenge: Once you have figured out how many there are in total, can you say the number sentence e.g. $2 + 5 = 7$.</p>



Thursday	To begin combining 2 groups of abstract representations and using the vocabulary involved in addition.	11.20am Maths Live on Zoom – Combining 2 Groups of Numbers Maths Task: Have a go at playing the Dice Addition Game. Carefully count the dots on each dice to work out how many dots you have altogether. Challenge: Can you write the number sentence? E.g. $3 + 6 = 9$
Friday	To begin exploring a number line to add 2 groups together.	Watch: The White Rose Session 5 video - https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/early-years/growing-6-7-8-week-2/ Maths Task: Play the number track game with somebody. Roll 2 dice. How many spots do you have altogether? Can you predict what number you will land on? How many more spaces do you need to move in order to win the game? Challenge: Can you create a number sentence to explain how many more spaces you need to move in order to win?
