This might depend on what equipment you have at home but see how many different activities you can play</p> <p>For example if you had a football at home you could play Basketball Netball Dodgeball. ( all with the same ball ) Football</p> <p>Now practice some of your skills: Passing</p>

With a grown up, talk about how the different people we have learnt about show: Compassion, Responsibility and Courage.  <b>Challenge:</b> How do you show our 3 school values each day?</p>
Thursday	RE	<p><b>Topic task:</b> Watch the parable of 'The Lost Coin':  <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yvHxUxjaboE">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yvHxUxjaboE</a>            Talk to a grown up about how small things matter and that we should help all living things because they are all important.  <b>Challenge:</b> Think about small ways that people help you every day. Create a thank you card for them</p>
