Monday	Phonics: to begin using the sounds they know to spell words with more than one syllable.	<p>9.20am - Live Phonics on Zoom – Spelling 2 Syllable Words</p> <p>Task: Have a go at spelling the words below using your phonic knowledge. Ask a grown up to read them out loud and see if you can write them down.</p> <p>bedroom, teacher, rooftop, pen-pot, sister, workman, bookshop</p> <p>Challenge: Can you add the sound buttons to your words? Look carefully for any digraphs and trigraphs.</p>
Tuesday	English: to retrieve information from books and to retell a story.	<p>9.20am – Live English (Reading) on Zoom – Emma's Lamb</p> <p>Task: Can you write a list or draw pictures of all of these things in the story: The Characters (who was the main character? What animals were in the story?) The Settings (what places on the farm did Emma and the lamb visit?) The Plot (what happened first, next, then?)</p> <p>Challenge: Can you retell the story to a grown up? Wednesday	Phonics: to begin to understand the composition of a sentence in writing.	<p>9.20am – Live Phonics on Zoom – Writing Sentences</p> <p>Task: Have a look at the writing frames. Choose at least 2. Can you write a sentence to describe what is happening in each picture? Remember a sentence needs a capital letter, a full stop and finger spaces.</p> <p>Challenge: Draw your own picture and write a sentence about it.</p> <p>This could be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - something you have really enjoyed learning about this half term - something you have done to help at home this week - your favourite part of the day
Thursday	English: to begin writing short sentences in meaningful contexts.	<p>9.20am – Live English (Writing) on Zoom – Modelled Writing</p> <p>Task: Can you draw a picture of Emma's Farm and write a description of it. What animals are on the farm? What are the different places on the farm? Have a go at writing at least 2 sentences. Remember capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you include some adjectives in your sentences? Remember these are our describing words that tell us more information about something e.g. Emma lives on a big farm. There is a little lamb.</p>
