Monday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To create a visual representation of the story. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Today we will explore 'Monday – The Mousehole Cat – Section 3' in the Zoom at 10:40am. You task today is a creative task. I would like you to create your own representation (picture) of this section of the story. You can do this as creatively as you wish. Some ideas include; drawing, painting, collage, pastels. Then add adjectives and verbs with adverbs around your picture to describe it.



Tuesday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To create an acrostic poem to describe Mowzer. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the Zoom at 10:40am we will explore 'Tuesday – The Mousehole Cat – Section 4' (one page is from yesterday and a new page for today). Today's task is to create an acrostic poem about Mowzer. You write the name Mowzer down the side and then create interesting sentences about him one linked to each letter.
Wednesday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To write a newspaper report about Tom and Mowzer. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the Zoom at 10:40am we will finish the book The Mousehole Cat. If you have time before the session think about how you think it will end and make a prediction. Your task today is to write a short newspaper report about Tom and Mowzer braving the storm to make sure everyone has food. There is a newspaper report template and a set helpful prompts to help you with how to set it out and what to include.
Thursday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To create an advert for the commemoration ceremony in Mousehole. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the Zoom today at 10:40 we will watch a video of the way they commemorate Tom Bawcock in Mousehole in Cornwall and discuss the different event that take place. Your task today is to create an advertisement for the commemoration ceremony in Mousehole. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You can present this in any way you like as long as you plan it out first and think carefully about the things you are going to include. Some ideas of things you could create are a poster, a newspaper advert, a tv advert. Use the book and the images from the book to inspire you with ideas for things you might include. Remember in our English work we use pencils and pencil crayons to help our presentation. This piece of work should not just be pictures, there needs to be writing included.
