Monday	History/Geography Music LO: The origin of chocolate, the Mayan legend	Complete the KWL Grid – Chocolate. Think carefully about all that you know about chocolate (not just that it tastes nice☺). Create at least 5 questions you would like to research. Do you know what the essential basic ingredient for chocolate is? It is the cocoa bean, which grows in pods on cocoa trees. Google cocoa pods and look at the images, they are amazing. • How long do you think people have been using cocoa beans to make chocolate? The earliest evidence of cocoa consumption found in Central America and dates back to around 1000BC! The Mayan civilisation used cocoa beans to make a drink called 'xocoatl'. It was an important part of both their social and spiritual life. Read the Quetzalcoatl Legend Sheet, which tells the tale of how the Aztecs believed a god brought the cocoa tree to earth. Retell the story creatively. You could create a story board, or a cartoon for example.
Tuesday	Art LO: Look at depictions of Quetzalcoatl. Consider the images of the deity and design own depiction Quetzalcoatl is being depicted by people in different forms today.	Read the Art Support sheet. Design and make a Quetzalcoatl mask.
