## Subject Specific Vocabulary

philosophy	Philosophy is a way of thinking about the world, the universe, and society.
justice	"a concern for justice, peace, and genuine respect for people"
Huang Hi/Yellow River	The second largest river in China, the principle river in Northern China and The Yellow River is often called the cradle of Chinese civilization.
democracy	Democracy means allowing citizens to make their own decisions for their personal lives.
Himalayas	The <i>Himalayas</i> , or <i>Himalaya</i> is a mountain range in Asia separating the plains of the Indian subcontinent from the Tibetan Plateau. The range has many of Earth's highest peaks, including the highest, Mount Everest (Nepal/China).
Beijing	<i>Beijing</i> formerly recognised as Peking is the capital of the People's Republic of China, the world's third most populous city.
truce	A truce is when two fighting sides declare peace or a break in the war.
Gobi Desert	The <i>Gobi Desert</i> is a large desert or brushland region in Asia. It covers parts of Northern and Northeastern China and of Southern Mongolia
temple	A building devoted to the worship of a god or gods.
Rights	a moral or legal entitlement to have or do something.
Responsibilities	a thing which one is required to do as part of a job, role, or legal obligation.
Ancient	belonging to the very distant past and no longer in existence.

- ☐ The 'Golden Horde' is the group of settlers from Mongolia that ruled over many other countries including Russia
- ☐ Confucious was a Chinese philosopher who brought about moral justice, kindness and social relationships
- ☐ The Terracotta Army is statue depicting the army of the first Chinese Emperor-Qin Shi Huan
- ☐ The Shang ruled from 1600 to 1046 B.C. and heralded the Bronze Age in China. They were known for their advances in math, astronomy, artwork and military technology
