<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Letters and Sounds• Use the Phonics Play website - Username: march20 and Password: home• Parents will need to choose phase 2 or 3, if you refer to the sheet I gave for the first week the first sounds are s, a, t these are phase 2. Phase 3 sounds start with j. Please stick to the phase that your child is working on. If you are unsure please message me on Tapestry and I'll let you know which phase you need. • Have a go at the 'Grab a Giggling Grapheme' game, choose either Phase 2 or 3 for your child.• <u>This week let's focus on these sounds</u>• Phase 2 group - s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d - can you play the Picnic on Pluto game (use Phase 2 Set 1)? Then can you create some 3 letter words using these letters, for example - pat, din, sip. Can you write the words down for a parent?• Phase 3 group - sh, th, ch - can you play the Picnic on Pluto game (use Phase 3 and choose the sh, th, ch digraphs)? Go on a word hunt around the house finding things that use these digraphs and write them down. For example shed, bath, chair.	
Activity 1 - Watch Jasper's beanstalk again. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can you retell the story to someone in your family? Or maybe Facetime a grandparent to tell them about the story?• Can you act out the story? Use toys, puppets or draw the characters.

Activity 3 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Can you draw a picture of how you planted your bean?• Can you label it? Using words like pot, soil, bean, water.
