Grammar: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Parenthesis-adding extra information using either brackets, commas or dashes. Complete the worksheet.• When reading the next chapters of Skellig-make a note of the use of parenthesis-can you find 6 examples?	
Activity 1 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read to the end of chapter 15 where Michael has another conversation about the mysteries of life. Think about what the similarities and differences are between Michael and Mina's opinions.• The main characters are Michael, Mina, Skellig, Dad and Mum. Choose 3 out of the 5 characters and write a short paragraph from their point of view about events in the story so far.	
Activity 2 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read to the end of chapter 22. This is where the strange creature reveals his name• Plan and prepare an interview with one of the characters either Skellig, Mina or Michael. Think about how the characters have been acting/behaving so far and the relationship they now all have with each other. Think of 3 or 4 questions to ask and what responses you think the characters would give and why.	
Activity 3 <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read the next 3 chapters up to the end of pg 90.Think about what would happen if an adult found Mina's diary and the story was leaked to the press. Write a letter from the person who found the diary to the editor of the local newspaper. Think about the use of formal language as you are writing to a newspaper-no chatty style!
