## Using 'An' or 'A'

**<u>RULE</u>**: Use 'an' before a word that starts with a **vowel** <u>sound</u>.

#### For example:



**an** <u>h</u>our – 'hour' does not start with a vowel (a, e, i, o or u) but it does start with a vowel sound.



**an** h<u>ou</u>r because the 'h' is silent. Tricky!
