Expressive Arts and Design

Use poster paints and a pallet to have a go at mixing colours. What happens if you mix red and yellow? Which colours do you think you need to mix to make pink or green?

Maths

At bath time or when your washing the dishes, use different containers to explore capacity. Which one holds the most/least? Can you make it full/half full?

Find some numbers around the house. Can you recognise them and tell an adult what they are called?

Construction challenge

Using different materials e.g. pasta, lego, marshmallows, build some houses. Which one is the strongest? What do you think it would be like to be a builder or engineer?

Using recycling materials make a junk model car. With an adult talk about mechanics and see if you can make the different parts of the car.
